Symposium on Medical Education

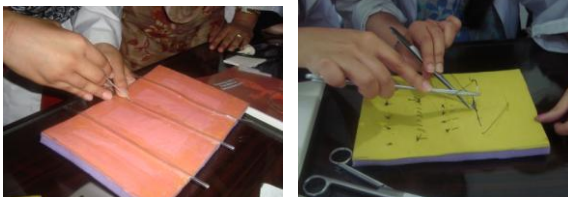
Date: 26th May 2010
